

COLORED CENTER TO OPEN JUNE 8th; GIFTS RECEIVED

The Community Center and Home Mission workshop for the colored will be opened on June 8 when children from 6 to 12 years old will be enrolled in homecraft work, and a teen age group will enroll for a sports group, according to Jeanie Kilgore, supervisor.

Plans for the children's nursery are expected to be completed by June 15, it was stated yesterday.

The homecraft group will meet each week day, excepting Saturday, from 3 to 4 o'clock. The book room will be open from 4 to 7 p. m. daily except Saturday, and will be open on Sundays from 3 to 6.

The supervisor said many gifts have been received by the colored community center, including books from the public library, tennis net from J. H. Garren, magazines from Mrs. Bradford Allen and Mrs. Ward, toys from Mrs. Wike, table tennis set from F. Staley, and chairs from St. Phillips auxiliary. The missionary circles of the First Baptist church are also working for the center, the supervisor said.
